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
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Introduction

Program Fees

Potential participants (PP) will get informed in the Program Fee Disclosure, a segment of our info session where we present a breakdown of payments that the applicant is mandatorily required to settle.

If (PP) is to decide to continue by installment in our J-1 visa cultural exchange program for teachers, he/she can discuss and agree with our team the number of amortization the participant wants to breakdown the principal payment.

Duration

The maximum duration that a teacher can stay in the country enrolled in the cultural exchange program is three years. But, in some case your program sponsor can grant you another one or two years addition.



Teacher CE Process

Potential participants (PP) will get informed of the Program Fee Disclosure during the segment of our info session where we present a breakdown of payments that the applicant is mandatorily required to pay the fees.

Phase 1

This phase consist of orientation, application background assessment, initial interview, and program sign up.

Placement Phase

During this phase, we will be endorsing the potential teacher to various school districts.

- 5. Release of job order from school

Phase 2

In the final phase, the potential teacher will be filing the DS-2019 form, and will undergo in an interview preparation with the U.S. embassy. Other final process will also be explained.

- 6. Submission of all document requirements to potential program sponsors.
- 7. Completion of the DS-2019 Form.
- 8. U.S. Embassy interview preparation.
- 9. Final interview
- 10. Resignation process
- 11. Departure

Who are qualified to join this program?

- Candidates must be a graduate of any bachelor or master's degree program and have at least 2-3 years of experience in the teaching fields. Candidates must be a graduate of any bachelor or master's degree program and have at least 2-3 years of experience in the teaching fields.
- Must be proficient in both speaking and written English.
- Teachers must have a sufficient funds to cover the living expenses in the United States. Teachers must have a sufficient funds to cover the living expenses in the United States.

US Student Visa Programs

F-1 Visa

It allows you to enter the country as a full-tile student at an accredited academic institution. You must enrolled in a program that culminates a degree, diploma or certificate and the school must be authorized by the U.S. government. F-1 visa can potentially allows you to work incampus and in some cases even off campus.

M-1 Visa

If you are planning to take a vocational or nonacademic programs, other than language training, then M-1 visa (vocational student) category is the visa that you must apply for, it can be extended for more than 3 years!

Specialty Occupations Programs

Employers in the United States are permitted to temporarily hire foreign workers in specialty occupations (e.g., IT, engineering, mathematics, physical sciences, medicine and health, and business). TalentBridge Visa Consultancy's H-1B program is here to help you navigate the complexities of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.

Health-care Industries

Nurse

According to the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, there were roughly a decline over the number of registered nurses in the healthcare workforce. As a result of this shortage, there were a ripple effect of rising health care costs and lower quality of life across the states.

As a result of this decline, some hospitals begin to rely on the healthcare expertise of foreign nationals to fill in the shortage. Foreign recruit nurses are able to work in the U.S. healthcare industry by either the Employment-Based Immigration (see below) or the H-1B Specialty Occupations or the Temporary Worker Visa.

Medical & Radiologic Technologist

Medical and Radiologic Technologist are critical in the healthcare system. Among the duties of these professionals are test and analyze body fluids, creating reports and findings, perform a series of radiographic examinations in patients, and many more.

With the healthcare system of the United States dwindling of healthcare professionals and assistant in the country, some hospitals decided to rely on foreign nationals to fill in the role. The H-1B Specialty Occupations is the tool that helps medical and radiologic technologist get employment in the United States. As temporary worker in the country, you will have the opportunity to enjoy and learn about the state-of-the-art healthcare facilities of the United States! Making your resume more attractive to potential employers both in your home country and in the U.S.



Physical Therapist

There will be plentiful of career opportunities in the United States for foreign physical therapists with in the next ten years, and it is expected to grow by 15%, opening about 13,900 roles annually (According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics).

Consequently, this makes the profession among the most in demand and attractive roles in the health care industries, and several medical and physical treatment facilities in the country might rely on foreign professionals that are willing to work under the H-1B Specialty Occupations temporary work visa program.

Education Industries
